

Course Information

Overview

Intermediate Rudiments (formerly Grade 1 Rudiments) will cover the foundations of music notation and vocabulary per the requirements prescribed by RCM Examinations and the Royal Conservatory Music Development Program. The target exam session for this course is May 10th, 2014.

Pre-Requisites

Mastering the material of *Basic Rudiments* is a pre-requisite for this class. Familiarity with the piano keyboard is recommended.

Co-Requisites

Although this course can be taken on its own merit, *Intermediate Rudiments* is a co-requisite for the completion of Gr. 6 practical examinations through *RCM Examinations* and the *Music Development Program*.

Instructor

This class will be taught by Scott Ashby, A.R.C.T., B.Sc., M.Mus. Scott has successfully guided many students through RCM theory requirements. He enjoys teaching music theory and desires to open up opportunities for students through new technology.

Enrolment

Class Schedule

Classes are 45 minutes in duration and will take place weekly on Wednesday evenings at 8:15pm ET, January 29th – May 10th, for a total of 10.5 hours of instruction.
